Mathematics: We are Mathematicians

In term 1 we practised our counting skills every day when counting the number of children in our group, counting the self-registration boards and counting through singing our days of the week song, as well as other number songs. Through play we have been busy exploring different 2D and 3D shapes. We have played different games using the big dice and giant numicon in our outdoor area.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development: We are self-aware

In term 1 we have been working hard on building positive relationships with peers and adults. We have practised turn taking, sharing and how to initiate play. This will continue to be a focus next term.

We have introduced talking about how we are feeling every morning in our group time. We have learnt about the different feelings and have learnt that everyone has different emotions. We will continue to learn about this through the story 'The colour Monster' in Term 2.
