

Within the summer term, all year 4 children will take the multiplication check. This requires them to answer twenty-five multiplication questions each within six seconds. Times tables are a key skill that helps your child throughout their learning journey in mathematics and will make future learning a lot easier! To ensure your child is confident, please support them to use TT Rockstars as this will prepare them well for the test ('soundcheck' mimics this). Fluency we do in class is really showing the work put in at home, thank you! Please speak to your child's class teacher for more information.

This term we will also be...

Linguists — We will be continuing to learn key Spanish vocabulary and working on our conversation skills.
