Understanding the World: We are scientists/ we are citizens

Our focus this term is for the children to learn about family celebrations. All children will learn that people have different ways of celebrating special times and learn about how these are celebrated.

Literacy: We are Writers

As Writers, we are continuing to develop our fine motor through a range of activities (see Physical Development for more info). Our writing station is proving popular with lots of children choosing to do mark-making whilst practising to hold a pencil.

Mathematics: We are Mathematicians

This term we are continuing to practise counting. To support with this in Preschool, we are using our "pointy finger" to count around the circle each morning. We will also be practising counting resources in the classroom such as block towers, cars and teddies., or how many shoes by the door.



Personal, Social & Emotional Development: <u>We are self-aware</u>

This term, we are continuing to practise growing our 'Gem Powers' to sapphire sit and listen and topaz talk during learning together times. This term, we will be learning about Opal power to support us in remembering to keep safe with our personal care. We will be practising to use a tissue for our noses and then put them in the bin as well as washing our hands after using the toilet.
