In our writing, we will write a non-chronological report about Henry VIII.

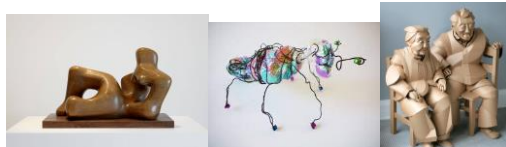


Year 3 Curriculum Newsletter Term 2
