We are Writers Narrative unit — Writing to entertain: How to Live Forever by Colin Thompson



As Writers, we will study the picture book 'How to live forever' to consolidate key writing features which we will use to write a high-quality setting description and dialogue:

figurative language, varied sentence types, speech punctuation, semi-colons, colons and passive voice.

We are Designers

Electronics and textiles
