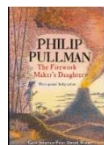


### Reading Raffle Challenge

### We are Writers

As writers we will be looking at **The Firework Makers Daughter** to help us learn how to use figurative language such as power of three, alliteration and similes. We will also use it to continue to practice punctuating speech in our writing. We will then be writing instructions on how to summon a goddess inspired by this text to further our understanding of the structure of instruction writing.



In spelling, we will be focusing on Y3/4 common exception words. We will continue our handwriting lessons as the progress from them has been huge!

### We are Citizens

### General Reminders:

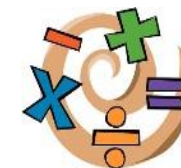
PE lessons are on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Please send your child into school in their trainers on these days.
