We are Writers

As writers, we will be ready and responding to the books *Journey to Jo'burg* and *Sulwe*. A key theme we will be studying is the 'authors message'. These stories have similar themes that highlight the importance of celebrating diversity. Throughout the texts we will be exploring how authors develop character through description and speech.

In our non-fiction unit, we will explore the features of persuasive letter. Using Journey to Jo'burg for inspiration, we will focus on key features and apply them to our own letter.

In our handwriting and spelling lessons, we will learn about words with the prefixes 'anti-, inter-, -tion, -ssion, -cian and sian) and how to apply these prefixes correctly whilst practicing our letter formation.

We will be learning all about light. We will be learning about how light travels, how shadows are created. We will also be focussing on the skills required to work as a scientist.




