We will use our knowledge to understand the effects of the Earth's magnetic poles, drawing connections to our earlier Earth Sciences topics in Year 3. We will combine this with being Designers to create our own working compasses!




General Reminders:

We are Mathematicians

Year 3 worked made a fantastic start at learning about unit fractions last term, and this term they will be building on this knowledge by looking at fractions with different numerators. We will then be revisiting polygons, focusing on the properties of parallel and perpendicular lines. Finally we will be looking at time and learning how to read analogue clocks.
