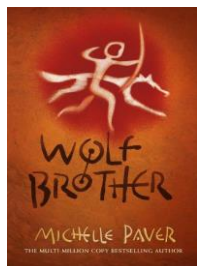


We are Writers

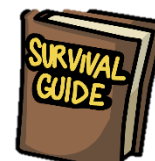
Reading
