For our Safeguarding Weekly Theme this week, and to raise awareness as we celebrate Safer Internet Day, we will be reminding children about keeping safe online. We will use the SMART acronym to help us remember key information:

S – keep all of your personal information **safe**

M – don’t **meet** up with strangers you have talked to online

A – think before you **accept** anything

R – not everyone is **reliable**

T – **tell** a responsible adult if you feel worried or uncomfortable.
