RE: Distance Learning for children isolating

Over the coming term, we are expecting that some children are likely to be isolating because they test positive for Covid-19. In order to support children to learn at distance, this is what you can expect.

Each week, every year group will create a timetable for the learning that will be happening in school and how this can be accessed at home. This timetable will be published on the year group WordPress websites. As part of the timetable, links to Live lessons via Microsoft Teams will be included, and learning resources (e.g. PowerPoint slides, worksheets, website information) will also be provided. This means your child will be able to access distance learning as soon as they are at home. You will no longer need to wait for learning to be emailed as you will be able to access it directly.

The expectation is that your children access distance learning only if they are well enough to do so. If your child is unwell, and therefore not able to complete the distance learning, please email the year group mailbox to let the teachers know.
