If you attended last year you will be aware that there are 2 other stages and if your child attends an after school club, music group or has auditioned for another performance then they will also be performing on one of these other stages at another time during the event as well. We will provide you with a full line up as soon as these other performances times have been confirmed. On the day there will be a full programme available and a notice board where we will notify you if there have been any last-minute changes to the programme.

The main gates will be opened early at 3:10pm and you will be able to collect your child from their classroom from 3:15 onwards. All children must be accompanied if they are entering Begfest.

We will need parents to ensure that their child is in RJB (Reception classroom) ten minutes prior to their performance time and then collected from RRF after the performance.



As Reception are performing first they will go straight from their classroom with their teachers to the stage so will need to be collected from RRF after they have performed at 4:00pm.

If your child is attending After School Club the members of staff will ensure that they are taken at the right time to perform with their year group and then returned to the After School Club afterwards. If you collect your child after 3:30pm from ASC you will be able to enter BegFest via the main playground gate.

We are really excited about holding this popular event but it can't happen without the generous support from the parent community.
