Parking in the Service Yard

We have a service yard at Begbrook which is located to the left of our main reception. This area is not a car park and should not be used as a place to park for drop off and pick-ups from school. Service vehicles are regularly accessing this space and so it is not safe for children and families to be in there. Unless you have been issued with a parking permit by a member of the Principal Team, we kindly ask that you find an alternative place to park – please consider using the Begbrook Community Centre as it is just a 3 minute walk down the road and there are always plenty of spaces. If you think that you would qualify for a parking permit (e.g. you hold a disability badge) then please contact a member of the Principal Team to discuss this further.

Parking Safely - reminder

We continue to notice and be made aware of potentially dangerous parking at the start and end of the school day. The main concerns are:

- Parking on double yellow lines and zig-zags
- Cars coming up onto the curve and pavement, even whilst children are walking past
- Parking on road corners opposite the school, making it very hard to see cars coming around the corner
- The speed of cars as they drive past the school

Once again, we would like to ask that you park carefully and with consideration to the safety of others.
